

# Holiday Tree Collection Schedule

**Attention Property Managers:** Tenants should place trees in the garbage enclosure for collection according to this schedule:

<b>Week of Dec. 31 - Jan. 4</b>	Complexes in the cities and unincorporated areas of Danville and Walnut Creek, plus Alamo, Diablo and Blackhawk.
<b>Week of January 7-11</b>	Complexes in the cities and unincorporated areas of Lafayette, Moraga & Orinda.
<b>Week of January 14-18</b>	Complexes who missed prior tree collections.
<b>After January 18</b>	If possible, cut tree and place in your organics cart or landfill dumpster, or call (925) 685-4711 to schedule removal for a fee.

# Tree Pickup Do's & Don'ts

## Do:

- Remove lights, ornaments, tinsel and trimmings from branches before placing near garbage enclosure.
- Cut in half all trees that are 8 feet or over in height.

## Don't:

- Flocked trees can be collected for a fee. Call (925) 685-4711. If cut to fit inside with the lid closed, flocked trees may be placed in your landfill container.
- Do not leave stands (whether plastic, metal, or wood) on the tree. Trees with these items still attached cannot be picked up.
- Do not leave lights, ornaments, tinsel, or other trimmings on the tree.

Tenants should place trees for collection in their nearest garbage enclosure.

Collected trees will be composted.
